- Navy trousers, skirt or shorts
- Leather black belt must be worn with trousers and shorts
- Striped blouse with the navy and maroon tie
- Striped shirt
- Navy tie must be worn with shirt in Terms 2 and 3 and on formal occasions
- Plain black leather polished, low-heeled lace-up shoes worn below the ankle
- Formal socks
- Formal hat or navy sun hat



Blazers

• School blazer must be worn by students in Years 11-12 during Terms 2 and 3 and on formal occasions.
